AN ACT Relating to Salary of Clerks in Office of Register of Deeds in
Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, ¶ 10, amended. Paragraph 10 of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 36 of the public laws of 1935, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Oxford county: for clerks in the office of the register of deeds, ~~eight hundred dollars~~, **\$1600**, and such additional amount as may be authorized by the county commissioners; for clerks in the office of the register of probate, \$800; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$800.'
