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**AN ACT Relative to Non-resident Guides.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 16, ¶ 3, amended.** Paragraph 3 of section 16 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows: 'A fee of \$3 shall be paid annually for the registration of a Class A guide and a fee of \$1 shall be paid annually for a Class B guide. Non-residents may be so licensed ~~for restricted areas~~ upon payment of a fee of \$20.'
