**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Franklin and Oxford  
Counties.**

---

**Fishing in certain waters; regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Rangeley Lake, Kennebago Lake, Kennebago Lake Little, Loon Lake, Saddleback Lake, Quimby Pond, Dodge Pond, Gull Pond, Long Pond in Sandy River Plantation, all in the county of Franklin, Mooselucmeguntic Lake and Cusuptic Lake, in the counties of Franklin and Oxford, to fly fishing from October 1st to October 15th, with a daily bag limit of 1 fish per person per day.
