AN ACT Relating to Privileges of Salesmen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 60, amended. The last sentence of section 60 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘No motor **car**, truck, tractor, or trailer registered under this section shall be used for other than demonstration.’
