STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 33, amended. The second sentence of section 33 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Before the license is granted, an applicant may shall be required to pass such physical examination and such examination by actual demonstration or otherwise as to his qualifications to operate a motor vehicle as the said secretary shall require; provided said secretary may waive such examinations in the case of applicants who have been duly licensed by this state to operate a motor vehicle during any one of the 3 preceding calendar years; and no license shall be issued until the said secretary is satisfied that the applicant is a proper person to receive it; no license shall be issued to any person under 15 years of age.'
