STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to the Maine Unitarian Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1875, c. 184, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 184 of the private and special laws of 1875 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section, and substituting in place thereof the following :

‘Sec. 2. Membership. The membership of this corporation shall consist of Unitarian or other liberal churches, parishes, societies or bodies within the state of Maine and organizations or voluntary associations allied in purpose to this corporation, and organizations or voluntary associations affiliated in any manner with a member church, parish, society, or body, or individuals who are members of any such church, parish, society, or body, and religious liberals not thus members ; or both, or all, and all in accordance with by-laws which may be adopted by the corporation on that subject.’
