AN ACT Limiting the Catching of Crabs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 2, § 97-A, additional. Chapter 2 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section to be numbered section 97-A and to read as follows:

‘Sec. 97-A. Limitation on season for taking crabs; penalty. No person, firm, association or corporation shall take crabs from the flats or waters of the state during the months of January, February and March. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days.’
