AN ACT Relating to Equity Powers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91, § 36, ¶ VIII, amended. Paragraph VIII of section 36 of chapter 91 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘VIII. Of bills of interpleader notwithstanding the complainant is a common carrier and as such has a lieu for carriage or storage upon the property which is described in the bill. **No complaint in interpleader shall be denied relief by reason of any interest in the fund or other subject matter in dispute. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to dispense with any of the other requisites for a bill of interpleader.**’
