STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Safeguarding of Clam Flats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Clams and clam seed, protected. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the legislature to safeguard the propagation of clams and clam seed along the sea coast of the state.

The commissioner of sea and shore fisheries is hereby directed and authorized to prepare and issue the necessary rules and regulations that would carry out the foregoing intent.

The sum of \$12,000 is hereby appropriated for the foregoing purposes, to be expended under the supervision of the said commissioner, as follows: \$1,500 in each of the following counties: York, Cumberland, Sagadahoc, Knox, Lincoln, Waldo, Hancock, and Washington.
