RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Casco Bay.

Fishing in Casco Bay, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting persons from ground fishing, except by hook-trawl and hand line, in the months of April, May and June, in Casco Bay, inside a line from Cape Elizabeth to Cape Small Point. Whoever shall violate the provisions of the said rule and regulation shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 for each offense.
