RESOLVE, in Favor of Wilson's Mills-Oquossoc Road.

Wilson's Mills-Oquossoc road; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$7,500 to buy supplies and materials to be used in the construction of the Wilson's Mills to Oquossoc road in Oxford and Franklin counties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road has been accepted as a W P A project at a cost of \$100,000. There is little or no money allocated by the federal government for supplies and materials.
