IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Allocating the Profits from State Liquor Sales to a Fund for Old Age Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Profits from sale of liquor to be allocated to fund for old age pensions. All of the net profits received by the state from the sale of liquor shall be, and hereby are, appropriated for the purpose of paying old age pensions according to the provisions of law.
