IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Alcohol.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sale of alcohol, regulated. Registered apothecaries may sell alcohol on receipt of a prescription from any physician, surgeon, osteopath, dentist, or veterinarian, duly licensed to practice in the state, and are hereby authorized to buy alcohol from within or without the state for the before mentioned purposes from any person or individuals or corporation authorized by law. Any person who sells alcohol contrary to the provisions of this act shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both such fine and imprisonment.
