STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Apportionment of Motor Vehicle Registration Fees Paid by Inhabitants of North Haven and Vinalhaven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Motor vehicle registration fees in North Haven and Vinalhaven, apportioned. 75% of all fees received from the inhabitants of the towns of North Haven and Vinalhaven by the state for the registration of motor vehicles shall be spent in said towns under the supervision of the state highway commission on the roads in said towns, in each town according to the proportion the amount paid by its inhabitants bears to the amount paid by the inhabitants of both towns.
