THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Penobscot County Court House.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Rooms provided for. The county commissioners for Penobscot county are authorized to provide, in the county court house at Bangor, rooms for use of parties and witnesses; conference and consultation rooms; adequate library facilities including proper care and use of books therein; and convenient elevator service.
