STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Recorder of the Old Town Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1917, c. 173, amended. Chapter 173 of the private and special laws of 1917 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Salary of recorder increased to \$600; justice of peace by virtue of office. The salary of the recorder of said court is hereby fixed at ~~five hundred dollars~~ **\$600**, annually, to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Penobscot. Said recorder by virtue of his said office shall be a justice of the peace for each of our several counties.'
