#### AN ACT Relative to Guide's Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 16, ¶ 3, amended. Paragraph 3 of section 16 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A fee of \$3 \$5 shall be paid annually for the registration of a Class A guide and a fee of \$1 \$3 shall be paid annually for a Class B guide. Non-residents may be so licensed for restricted areas upon payment of a fee of \$20 \$40. Persons licensed under this section may hunt and fish by virtue of their guide's license.'

'This act shall take effect January 1, 1938.'
