IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Duties of School Committees or Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Duties of school officials further defined. No school committee or official shall inquire concerning, or require or solicit from an applicant for a position in the public schools, any information as to his/her religious belief, creed or practice, or his/her political opinions or affiliations; and no appointment to such position shall be in any manner affected thereby. Violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.
