STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Guilford and Sangerville Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1911, c. 201, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 201 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof.
- 'Sec. 16. Acquisition of properties necessary to make act valid. If said Water District shall fail to acquire the plant, properties, franchises, rights and privileges owned by said Guilford Water Company and Sangerville Water Supply Company, aforesaid, by purchase, or to file its petition to take the same by the exercise of the right of eminent domain as hereinbefore provided, in either case before the 1st day of July 1940, this act shall become null and void.

Said district shall not begin to furnish water under this act until it shall have acquired the properties of said Guilford Water Company and Sangerville Water Supply Company, as hereinbefore provided.'
