### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, In Favor of the Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society,

Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society, appropriation for. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$500 to be paid to the Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society to aid in the repair and maintenance of the exhibition buildings and grand stand belonging to the said society located within the town of Monroe; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society has regularly held an annual exhibition on its grounds at Monroe and has endeavored to provide agricultural displays that were educational and helpful to farmers of the counties concerned. With the discontinuance of the fair at Belfast it is now the only agricultural fair held in Waldo county.

For the past several years the society has met bad weather conditions and for this and other reasons has been unable to qualify under the state stipend law which provides that a society must pay at least \$400 in premiums in order to share in such stipend. Buildings of the society are getting into bad repair and it is proposed to use this money exclusively for permanent improvements to the property of the society.
