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**AN ACT Relating to Practice of Optometry Defined.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 21, § 48, last ¶, amended.** The last paragraph of section 48 of chapter 21 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘An ophthalmic lens within the meaning of this and the following section shall be any lens which has a spherical, cylindrical, or prismatic power or value, ~~and~~ **or any lens is** ground pursuant to a prescription’.
