STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Political Caucuses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 7, § 50, amended. Section 50 of chapter 7 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 50. Exceptions. The provisions of the 11 preceding sections shall not apply to towns of less than two thousand 350 inhabitants, nor to cities wherein the calling and holding of caucuses is regulated by special law.'
