**RESOLVE, in Favor of Kenney Bros. Inc., of Portland.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Kenney Bros., appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$2,541.65, to be paid to Kenney Bros. Inc., successors to Kenney Bros. & Wolkins of Portland, for desks and furniture necessary to equip school building which was burned and rebuilt in 1930, in the town of St. Francis.
