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**AN ACT** Relating to the Use of Check Lists in Sanford.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1935, c. 72, additional.** Section 3 of chapter 72 of the private and special laws of 1935 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph, to be numbered paragraph (k), and to read as follows:

‘(k) The check list used under this act at town meetings shall be used also at all other elections held in said town, subject to the provisions of the general law. All voters whose names are on the check list now used in said town for all other elections and whose names do not now appear on the check list used for town meetings in said town may have their names enrolled on the said check list for town meetings at any time, including the day of any election, within 1 year from the effective date of the provisions of this paragraph.’
