AN ACT Relating to Trapping Season in Oxford County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 72, amended.** The 11th and 12th lines of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'October 16th to February 1st.—~~Oxford~~, Penobscot and Waldo.

October 16th to February 15th.—Franklin and Oxford.'
