**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain
Interest of the State in Hurricane Island.**

Forest commissioner authorized to convey state's interest in Hurricane Island. Resolved: That the forest commissioner as land agent be, and hereby is, authorized to convey by a deed of quit claim the interest of the state in Hurricane Island, so-called, in Penobscot Bay, in the county of Knox, to the inhabitants of the town of Vinalhaven.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Some 40 or 50 years ago, Hurricane Island was incorporated as a separate town. After some time the town was deorganized. As the island is contiguous to the town of Vinalhaven the town believes it should be part of that town.
