A N A C T R e l a t i n g t o S t a t e B o a r d o f A r b i t r a t i o n .

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 54, § 6, amended. The last sentence of section 6 of chapter 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each of said arbitrators shall be entitled to receive ~~three dollars~~ \$10 for each day of actual service, to be paid by the treasurer of state on a warrant drawn by the governor and council.'
