STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Loads to be securely bound. No person shall operate upon any way or bridge any truck or trailer carrying an unsecurely bound load thereon.

Sec. 2. Riding on outside of vehicle prohibited. No person shall ride upon the running-board, fender or bumper of any motor vehicle when operated upon any way or bridge.
