STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Appropriating Money for the Maintenance, Supervision, Use and Development of State Parks.

Maintenance of park areas; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$15,000 for the fiscal year 1937-38 and \$15,000 for the fiscal year 1938-39, to be used for the maintenance, supervision, use and development of the park areas under the jurisdiction of the state park commission, if and when, upon the approval of the governor and council, said park areas shall be conveyed to the state of Maine by the United States Government, or other park areas that may be acquired by said commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The United States Government has already expended large sums of money upon several park areas which it has acquired in different sections of the state of Maine, and it is the intention of the United States Government to convey to the state of Maine said areas for park and recreational purposes. These several park areas are situated in different sections of the state and if accepted by the state of Maine, will be of inestimable value to the citizens of Maine, and to the tourists who will visit the state each year. In order to properly care for and maintain these parks, it will require the sums called for in this resolve.
