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**RESOLVE**, in Favor of the Town of Penobscot.

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**Town of Penobscot; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of the town of Penobscot, the sum of \$9200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1938, and \$9200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1939, to aid in repairing the road beginning at the end of the improved road, and extending in an easterly direction on the road from Orland to Bluehill, a distance of approximately 2.3 miles. Any unexpended balance at the end of each fiscal year shall be available for construction of the same on any succeeding fiscal year. Funds shall be taken for this purpose from the general highway fund, and shall be expended under the supervision of the highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road is in very poor condition, and in need of repair.
