RESOLVE, in Favor of Manzie I. Rogers, of Bangor, Maine.

Manzie I. Rogers, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$9,300, to be paid to Manzie I. Rogers, of Bangor, for labor and materials furnished on concrete highway N. B. M. 91-E, in Brewer, Maine, also for rental of road machinery and equipment belonging to said Manzie I. Rogers, and used by the state, said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The amount of \$7,000 asked is for the loss of yardage and shortage on materials; the amount of \$2,300 is for the use of machinery that was let to several contractors of the state highway department. Mr. Rogers put his bill in for this amount to the state highway commission and as yet has received no compensation for same.
