**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Eagle Lake.**

---

**Town of Eagle Lake, compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$2000 to be paid to the town of Eagle Lake for the purpose of aiding said town in the construction of a school annex.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The tax rate of Eagle lake during the past 5 years has never been under 75 mills. Last year the rate was 89 mills. Appropriation for educational purposes was from 20 to 30 mills each year during the last 5 years. The town debt is about \$30,000. There are from 50 to 75 children who would like to enter high school, but are unable to do so as the parents are too poor to pay tuition in other towns. Those who are able to pay tuition are sending their children to towns outside Eagle lake, which is costing the state and town combined from \$500 to \$1000 each year.
