**AN ACT Relative to Regulating the High and Low Water Mark on Lake Moxie.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**High and low water mark on Lake Moxie, regulated.** No person, firm or corporation shall so operate any dam, water gates or fish screen that the height of water in Lake Moxie or Moxie Pond, so-called, in Somerset county, shall be raised more than 5 feet above, nor be lowered more than 5 feet below the normal water level of said pond.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each offense.
