STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Mileage Compensation for County Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Limitation on remuneration from county for travel. All persons entitled to receive remuneration from any county for travel shall be paid at the rate of 7c per mile travelled, and in no case shall more than I person receive pay for mileage incurred in any I vehicle, except in the case of either a hired or public conveyance where a regular price is charged or fare collected in which case all persons shall be reimbursed according to actual price or fare paid.
- Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
