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**RESOLVE, Authorizing Compensation for Paul F. Fitzpatrick, of

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**Paul F. Fitzpatrick, compensated. Resolved:** That the treasurer of the county of Kennebec, be, and hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed to pay to Paul F. Fitzpatrick, of Gardiner, the sum of \$183.25 for additional services as recorder of the Gardiner municipal court for the period from December 4, 1936 to January 28, 1937.
