STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Amateur Sports on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 39-A of chapter 245 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 39-A. Sunday sports legalized. In any city or town that shall so vote as hereinafter provided, it shall be lawful to engage in as a participant, manager or official, or to attend as a spectator, any outdoor recreational or competitive amateur sport or game, except boxing, horse-racing, air circuses or wrestling, between the hours of 1 P. M. and 7 P. M. on Sunday.

As used in this and the 5 following sections the words amateur sport or game shall mean any sport or game the participants in which are otherwise gainfully employed and to which they do not devote a major portion of their time and effort.'
