STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of the County Attorney of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 38, amended. The 5th line of section 38 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars \$2500.'
