**AN ACT Relative to Game Preserve in the Towns of Limington and Hollis
in York County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The game preserve established in the towns of Limington and Hollis in York county by chapter 135 of the public laws of 1935 be, and hereby is, extended for a period of 2 years from June 30, 1937 to June 30, 1939.
