IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Certain Town Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 86, additional. Section 86 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof, the following words:

‘Towns having 6000 or more inhabitants, where the offices of selectmen, assessors and overseers of the poor are combined, may fix such annual compensation for said selectmen, assessors and overseers of the poor as may be commensurate with the duties of the offices.’
