## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for Licenses and Permits for Outdoor Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 163 § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 163 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 2. Permits.** No person, firm or corporation shall after the 1st day of January next following the effective date of this act erect or maintain upon real property any outdoor advertising structure, device or display, including those now or hereafter existing, until a permit for the erection or maintenance of such structure, device or display shall have been obtained from the commission. The provisions of this section shall not apply to outdoor advertising structures, devices or displays upon or within 200 feet of the building wherein the goods advertised are manufactured or sold or the business or profession advertised is carried on or practiced, or which advertise the real property upon which the same may be for sale or for rent, provided that such structures, devices or displays shall not exceed two in number and that neither shall be of an area greater than 100 square feet or shall endanger the safety of persons using the highways.'
