RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Sell Certain Land.

Forestry department authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is authorized to sell the following described lot to Samuel J. Pennington, Bridgewater, Maine, for the sum of \$340.40:

Lot 29 of 199 acres in Township D, Range 2, W. E. L. S., Aroostook County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lot, reputed to be owned by John DeLong of Bridgewater, was acquired by the Forest Commissioner in behalf of the State in 1923 for non-payment of 1921 taxes. It is understood,—that Mr. Pennington sold this lot to Mr. DeLong about a year ago and took back a mortgage; that Mr. DeLong was supposed to have paid the back taxes but has not done so; that there has been no foreclosure of Mr. Pennington's mortgage.

The taxes in arrears with interest and advertising to February 1, 1937 amount to \$340.40. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the State Tax Assessor.
