STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT for the Protection of Rhodedendron Maximum Linnaeus and Kalmia Latifolia Linnaeus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain plants protected. Whoever without the consent of the owner of the land whereon the same may be growing injures, destroys, digs up or removes any rhodedendron maximum linnaeus or kalmia latifolia linnaeus, or any part or parts of the plants of either of said species growing upon the land of another shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100, and in addition thereto shall be liable to the owner of the land upon which the same was growing in an action of trespass in treble damages.
