STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Bounty on Bears in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Killing of bears in Washington county lawful. It shall be lawful to hunt and kill bears in the county of Washington.

Sec. 2. Applicability of certain parts of the present law. The provisions and requirements of the 2nd paragraph and of the 3rd paragraph, except as to the signature of a fish and game warden or chief warden, of section 79 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, shall apply to the same extent and in the same manner as therein provided.
