AN ACT Relative to Importation of Wild Birds or Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 54, amended. Section 54 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person shall introduce or import any wild bird or wild animal, ~~except for captivity purposes, or dead body~~ or part thereof, of any kind or species into the state, or receive or have in possession such wild bird or wild animal, ~~or dead body~~ or part thereof, so introduced or imported, without written permission of the commissioner.'
