AN ACT Relating to Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to be numbered (9), and to read as follows :

‘(9) Any citizen of the United States who is a resident thereof may procure a 10-day fishing license good for 10 days from the date of purchase thereof, upon the payment of \$2.15, 15 cents to be retained by the agent issuing the same; said days must be plainly enumerated on the face of the license.’
