STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Opening all Tributaries of Cobbosseecontee Lake to Fishing.

Fishing in Cobbosseecontee lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening all tributaries of Cobbosseecontee lake, in the county of Kennebec, to fishing, provided, however, that no fish taken shall be less than 7 inches in length, and provided further that not more than 6 fish shall be taken by any I person in any I day.
