RESOLVE, in Favor of Dredging Chandler's River, Jonesboro.

Dredging Chandler's river, Jonesboro. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1000, in part payment of the expense of dredging Chandler's river in Jonesboro. Said sum is to be expended by the state highway commission in collaboration with the United States government. In the event that such dredging is not done, this resolve shall become non-operative.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The United States government recently has made a survey looking toward the dredging of Chandler's river. This resolve is intended to show the interest of the state of Maine in the furtherance of this project.
