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**A N A C T R e l a t i n g t o t h e C o m p e n s a t i o n o f C o u n t y C o m m i s s i o n e r s o f  
A n d r o s c o g g i n C o u n t y .**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 125, § 43, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 43 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 70 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby further amended to read as follows :

'Androscoggin, ~~\$750~~ \$1200, except the chairman of said commission who shall devote each full working day to his duties, which shall be hereby increased by adding to them the superintendence of the county buildings, and for all his services his annual salary shall be the sum of \$2,000.'
