#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Granting the State Highway Commission Authority to Allow the Erection of Posts and Archways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Permits. The state highway commission hereby is given authority to issue permits to any person or organization to erect posts for the purpose of directing traffic, and for the erection of archways over the highways of the state.
- Sec. 2. Authority. The state highway commission shall direct the points where such posts and archways may be erected, the manner of such erection, and the text of any information written or printed thereon.
