**RESOLVE, in Favor of a Road in Indian Township No. 3.**

---

**Road in Indian Township No. 3; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$8000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1938, to aid in laying out and building a road in Indian Township No. 3; said road will begin at a point near the Bangor & Aroostook railroad station at Norcross, and extending to the east branch of Penobscot river, a distance of approximately  $1\frac{3}{4}$  mile. Any unexpended balance at the end of the fiscal year shall be available for construction of the same on any succeeding fiscal year. Funds shall be taken for this purpose from the general highway fund, and shall be expended under the supervision of the highway commission.
